Balance 15-10% is released on State government's certification of quantity in m-FMS (Fertilizer Monitoring System) and fertilizer receipt confirmation by retail dealers.</p> <p>b) SSP: 85% (90% with Bank Guarantee) of claim of subsidy paid on 1st point sale of fertilizers in the districts. Balance 10-15% claim is released subject to State Government's certification on quantity and quality in m-FMS as well as fertilizer receipt confirmation by retail dealers through m-FMS.</p>
